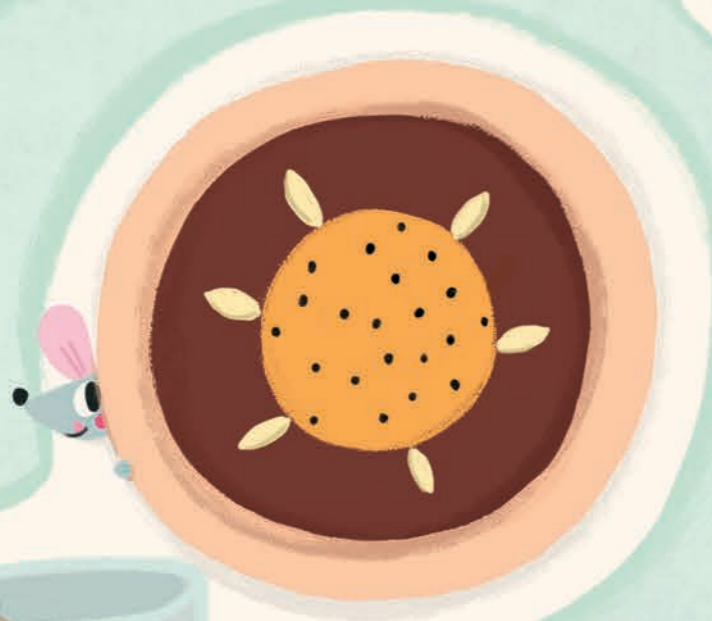
CIRCLE
