Can you spot ...

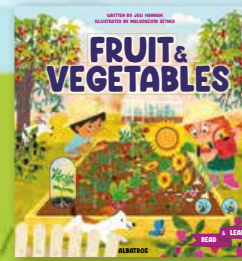
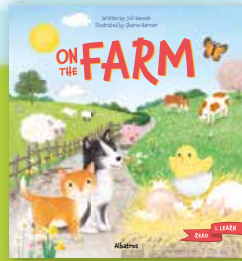
- a feed bag
