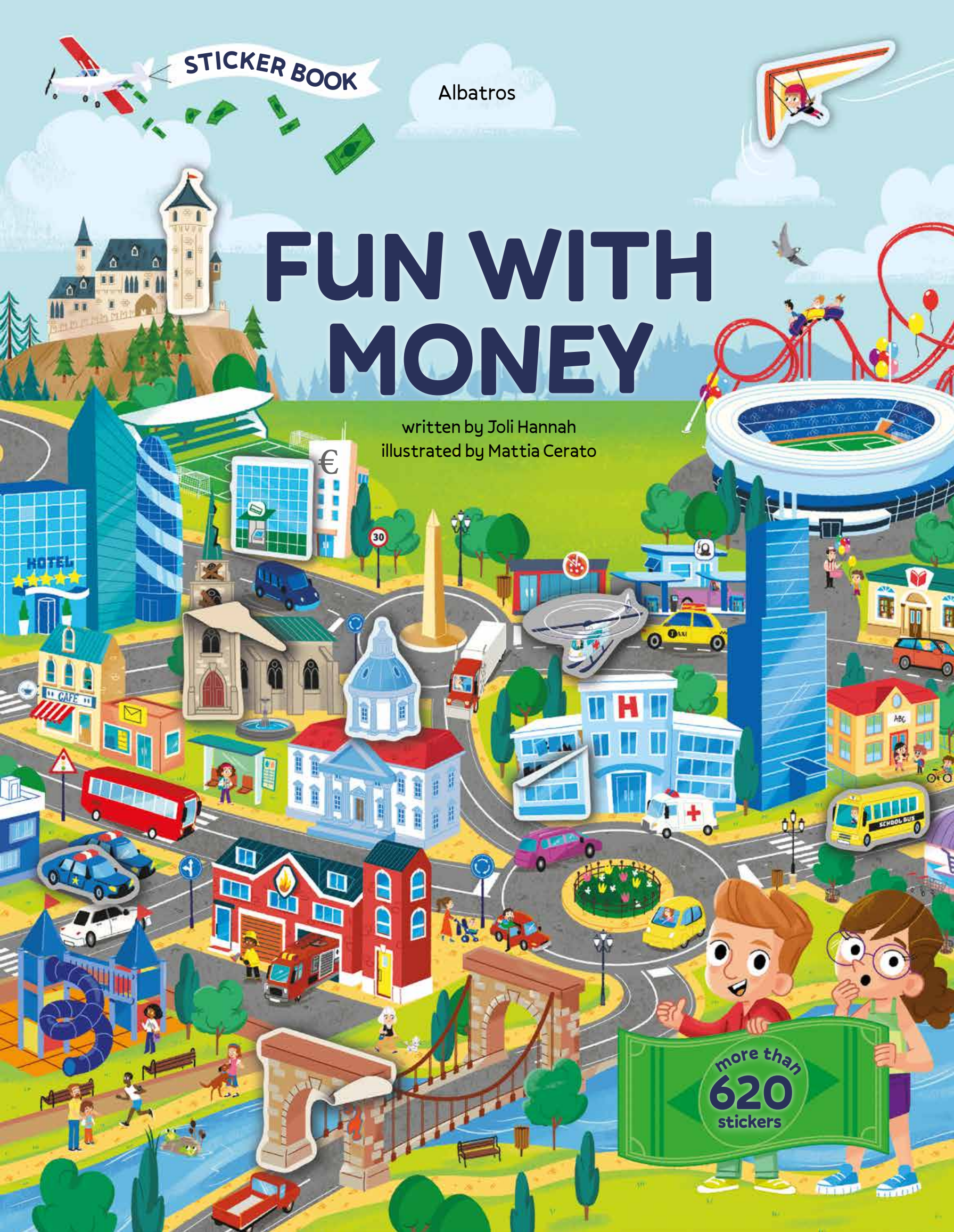

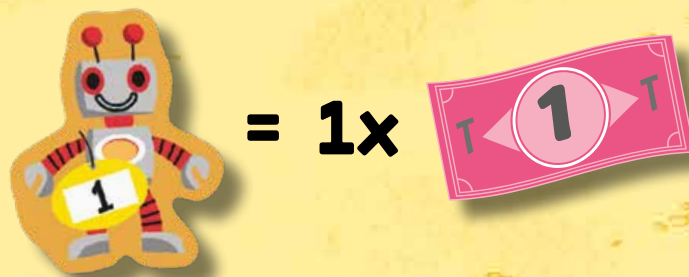
# THE TOLLAR STORE

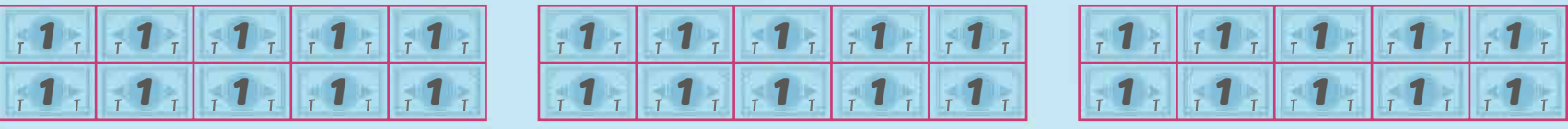

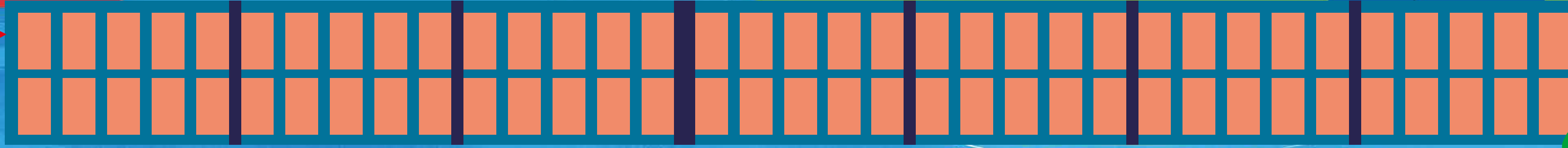


# STATE MAINTENANCE
