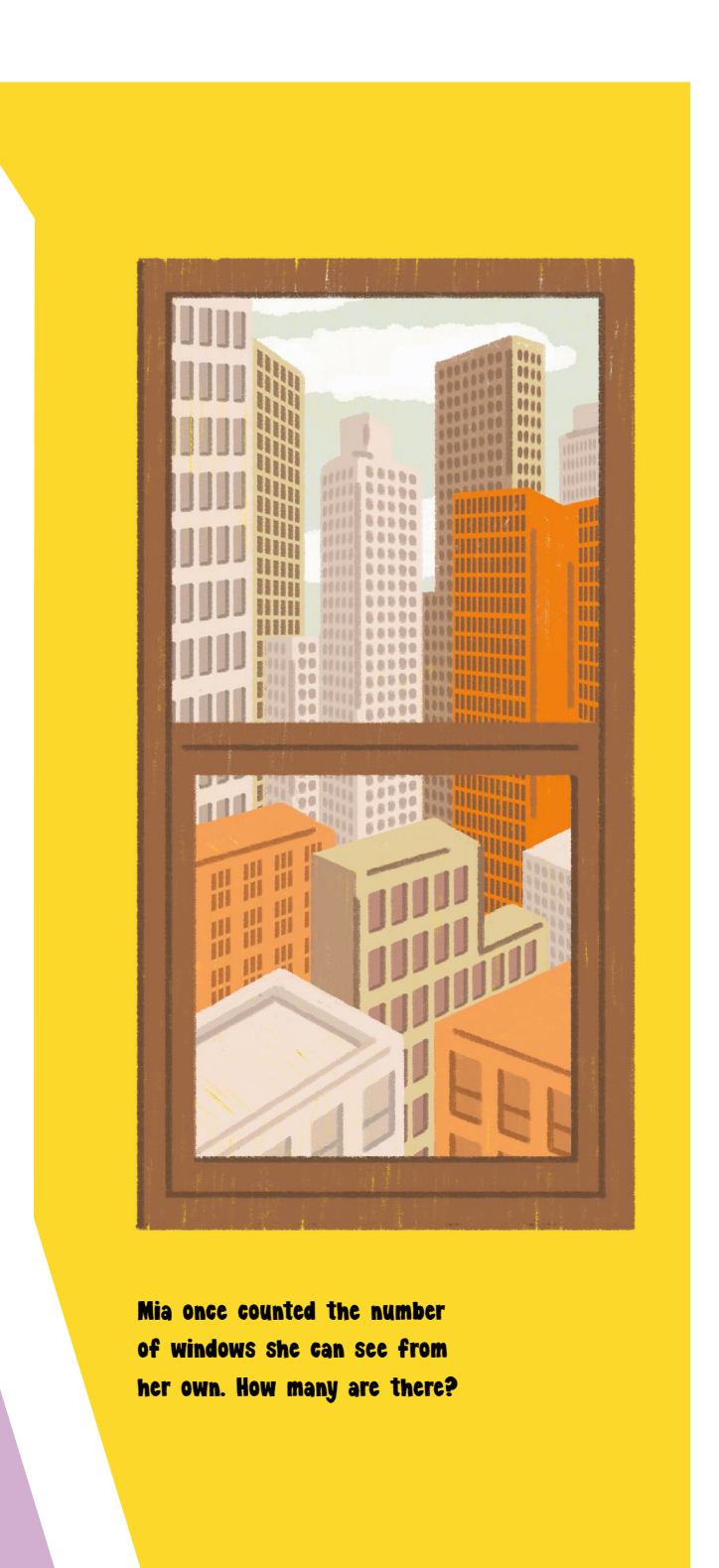

Mia once counted the number of windows she can see from her own. How many are there?



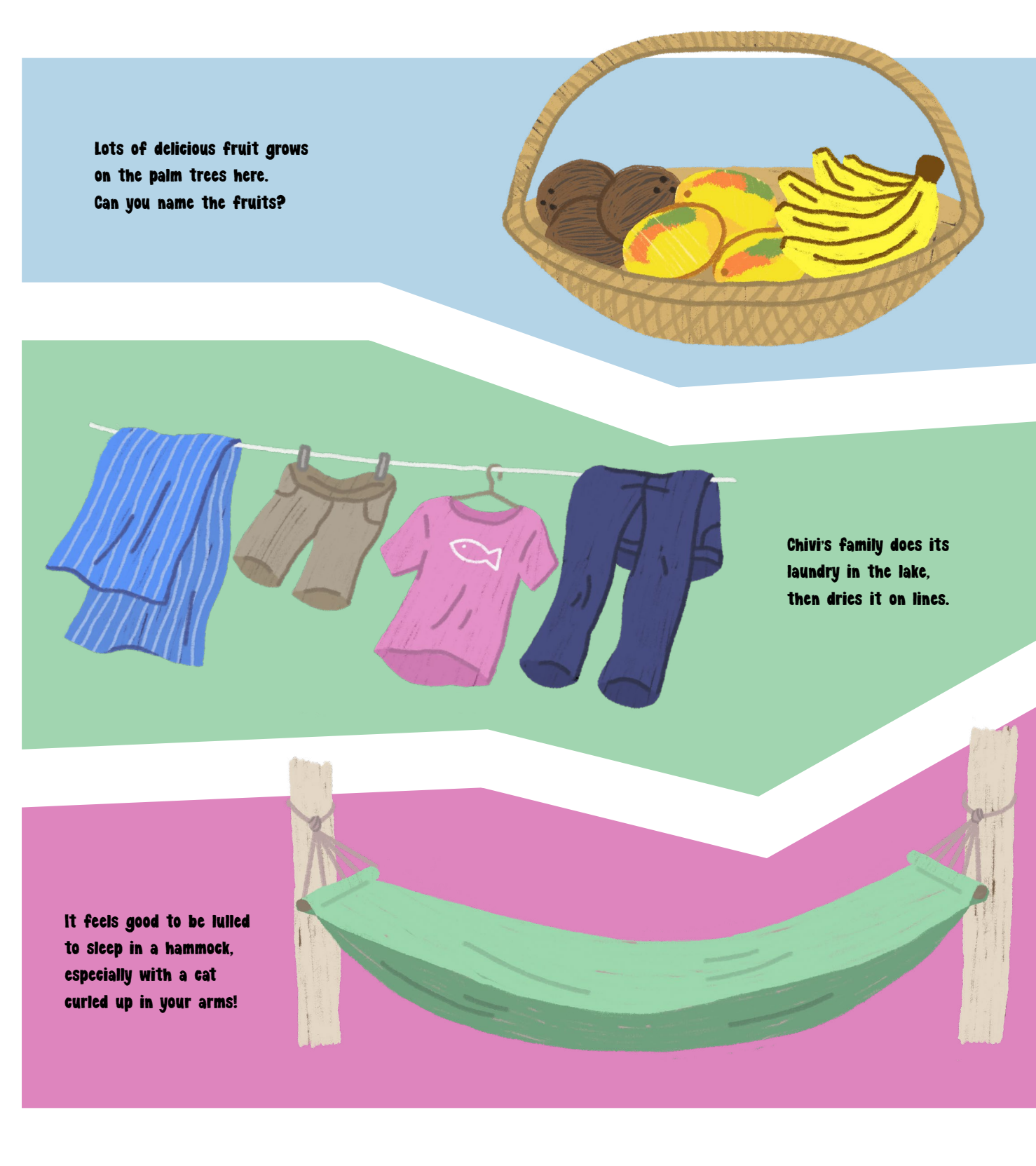


**CHIVI LIVES IN A HOUSE ON STILTS**

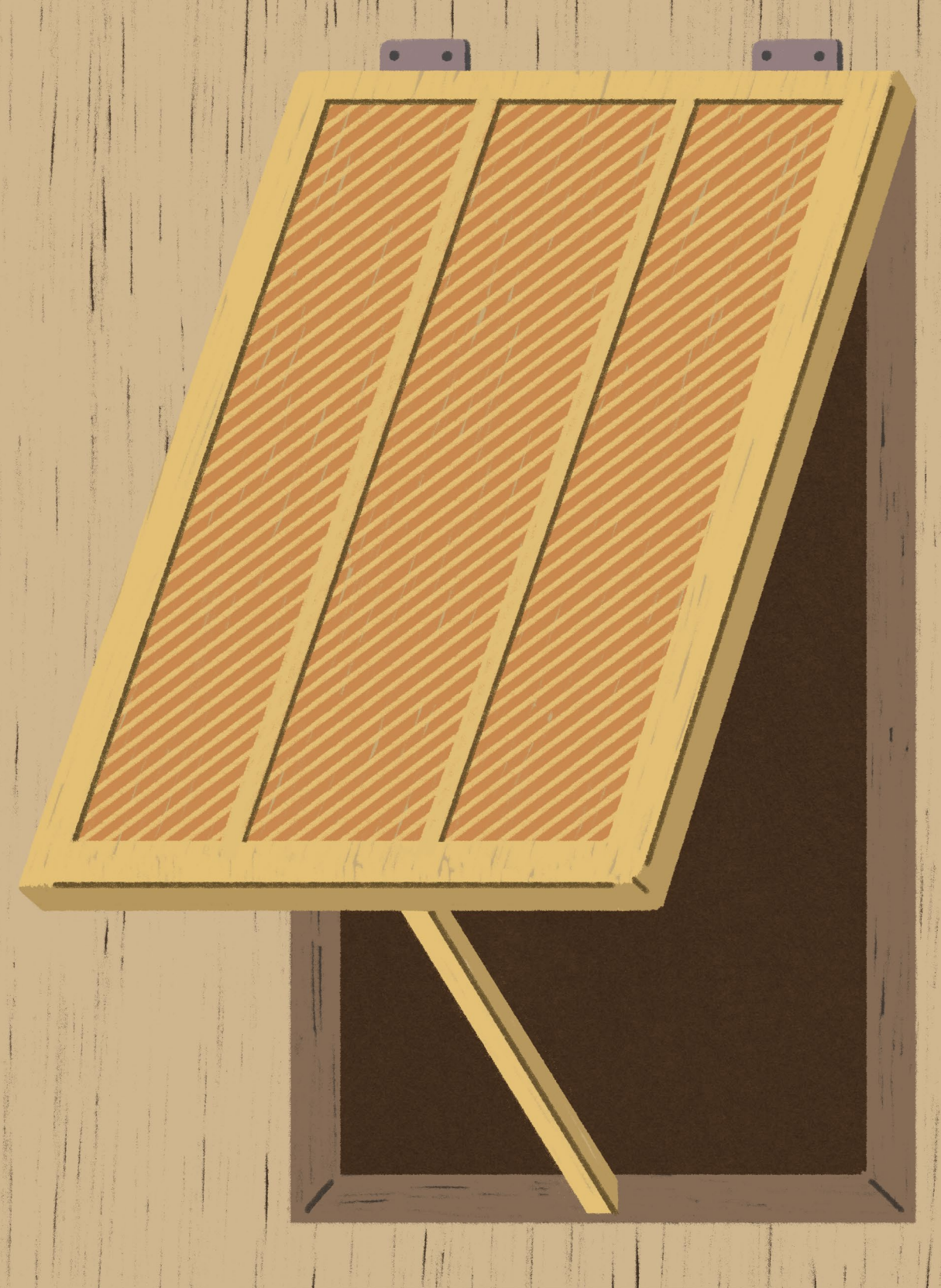
There's a yummy smell of baked fish. Can you find the net Chivi's dad fishes with every morning?

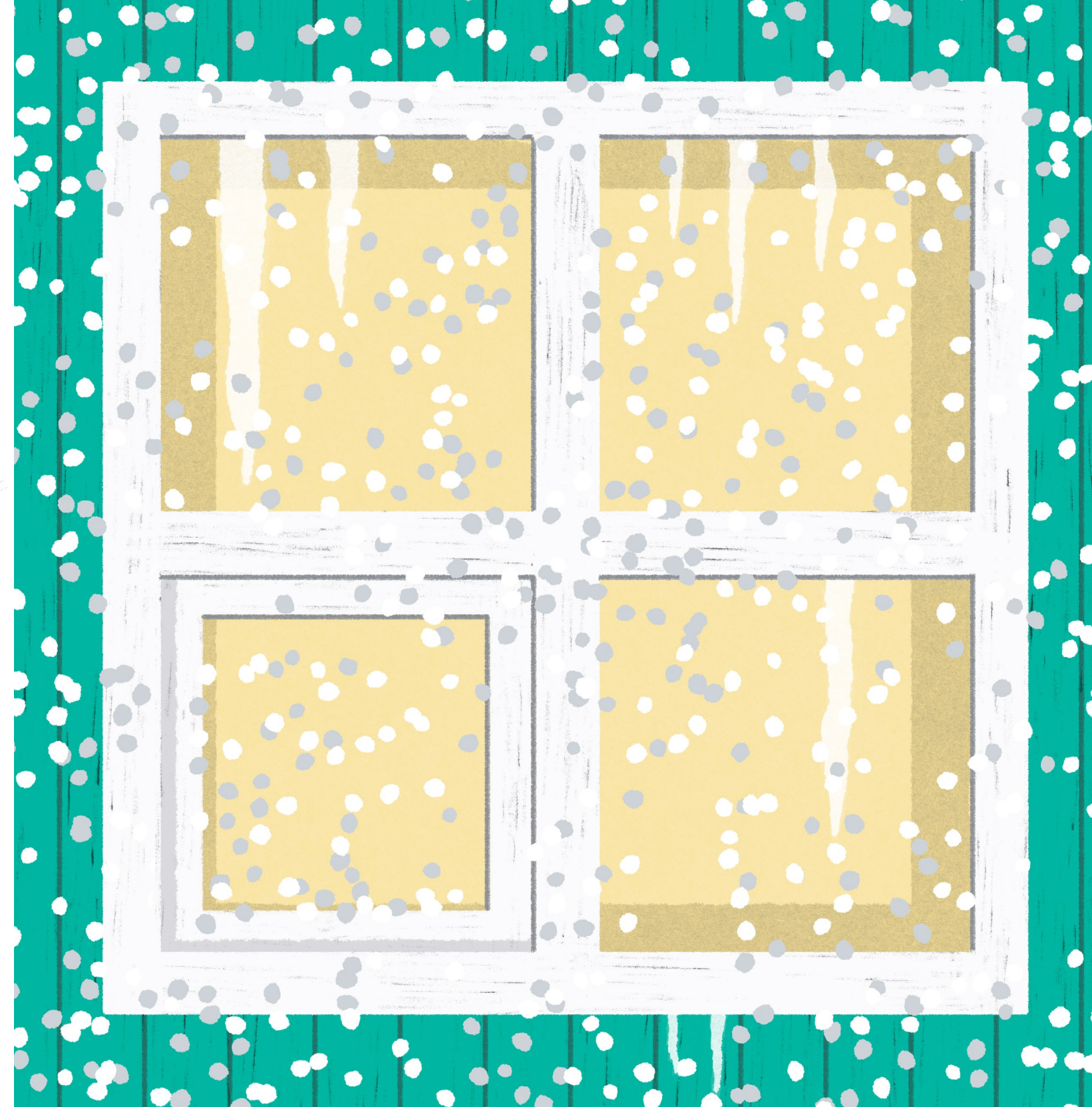
