


















Create your own mandalas

- 1. Take a sheet of unmarked white paper. Card is ideal, but you can also get a nice result with plain paper.
- 2. Draw a large circle. You can do so by hand, although if you already work with a compass, you will know that it is the perfect tool.
- **3.** Divide the circle into several regular parts. Here are eight equal sections. You can do this using a ruler with a scale.
- **4.** Draw small circles inside the large one. In this picture we have added only two.




5. With an ordinary pencil, decorate the mandala as you choose. Working on one layer at a time. If you want your mandala to be regular, make same shapes in each part of a given layer.





6. Decorate the other layers of the mandala in the same way, one layer at a time. Then colour the picture as you choose.



Extraordinary, sparkling pictures! The vibrant colours of the diamond (crystals) will bring the mandalas to life, giving them an almost unreal sparkle. The finished pictures can be given as presents or displayed in your room. This book contains everything you need to get creative. It is intended especially for children who are new to diamond art: the diamonds are bigger, and the pictures are simpler. It doesn't take long to make the pictures, but the results are truly impressive.
