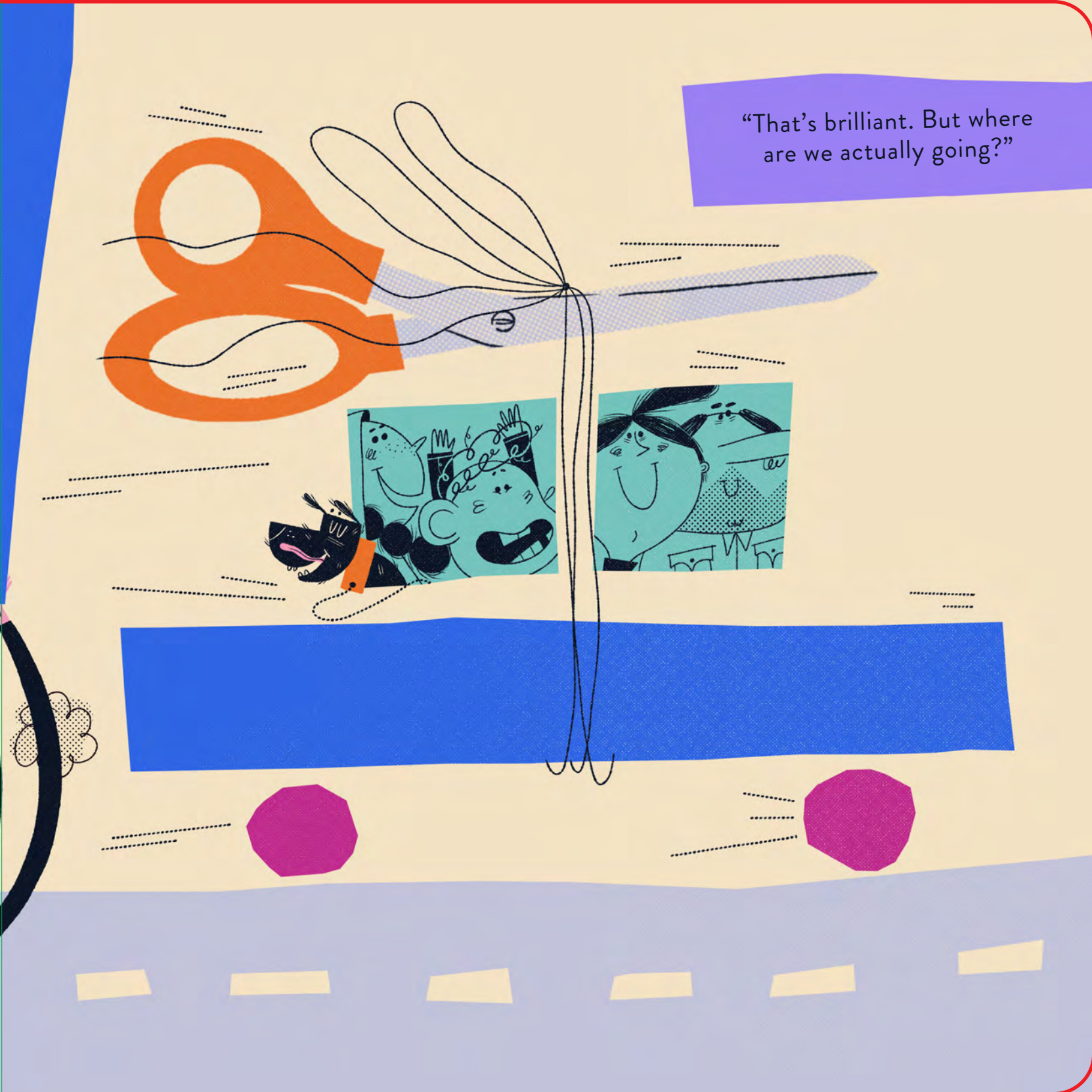

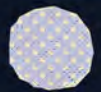




"To our new house."

"It may only be three squares, two rectangles and a triangle, but it's cosy ... and just look how much space there is around it," called out Dad.

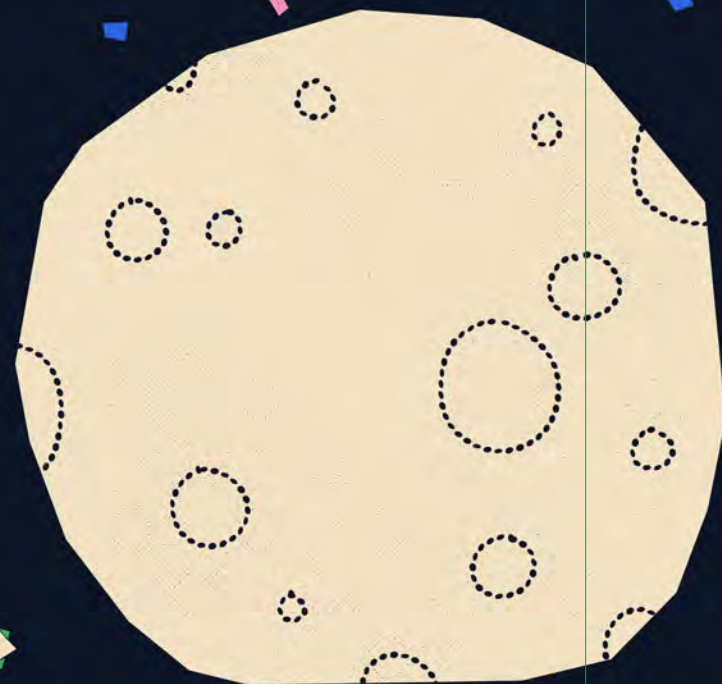

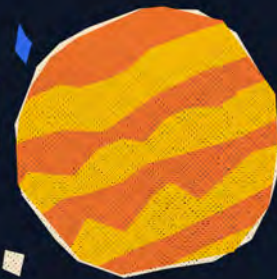

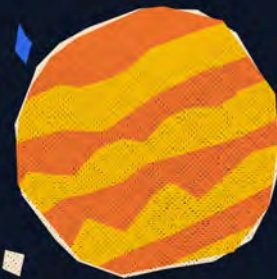
